

## Citing an Article or Essay from Learning Literature

The format you use will vary depending on whether the article is original to the database or a reprinted article or essay.

### **Format for article ORIGINAL to Learning Literature:**

“Title of the Work.” *Original Source of Work. ProQuest Learning Literature*. ProQuest, Date of publication. URL. Accessed date.

### **Examples:**

“The Short Story.” *ProQuest Genre Pages. ProQuest Learning Literature*. ProQuest, 2016.

### **Format for Article REPRINTED on Learning Literature:**

Author or Editor. (Last name, First name. Add ed. for editors) “Title of Original Article.” *Title of Original Source* Date of Original Source: Page(s) in Original Source. *ProQuest Learning Literature*. ProQuest, Current Year. URL. Accessed date.

Example:

Palmerino, Gregory J. "Steinbeck's 'The Chrysanthemums.'" *The Explicator* Spring 2004: 164.

**Format for Literary Essay REPRINTED on Learning Literature:**

Author or Editor. (Last name, First name. Add ed. for editors) "Title of Essay." *Title of Source*

*Essay is from*. Publisher of Source Essay is from, Date of publication. *ProQuest Learning Literature*. ProQuest, Current Year. URL. Accessed date.

Example:

Wyatt, David, ed. "Pilgrims' Politics: Steinbeck's Art of Conversion." *New Essays on the*

*American Novel*. Cambridge University Press, 1990. *ProQuest Learning Literature*.
